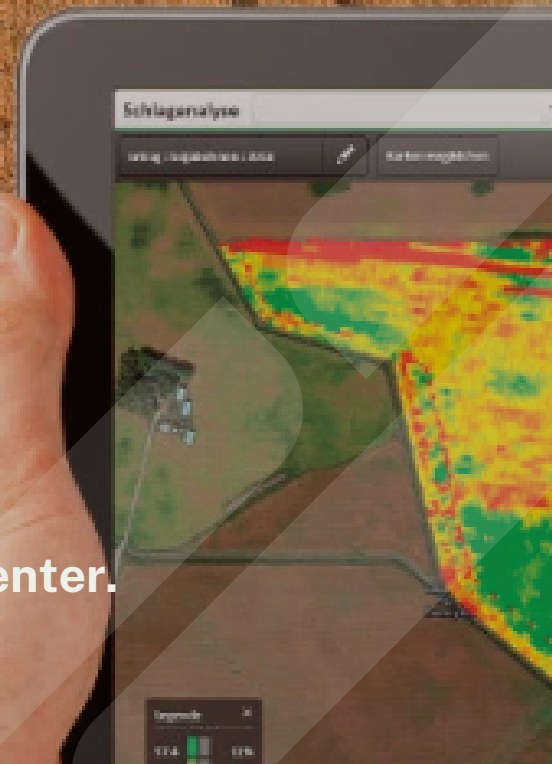

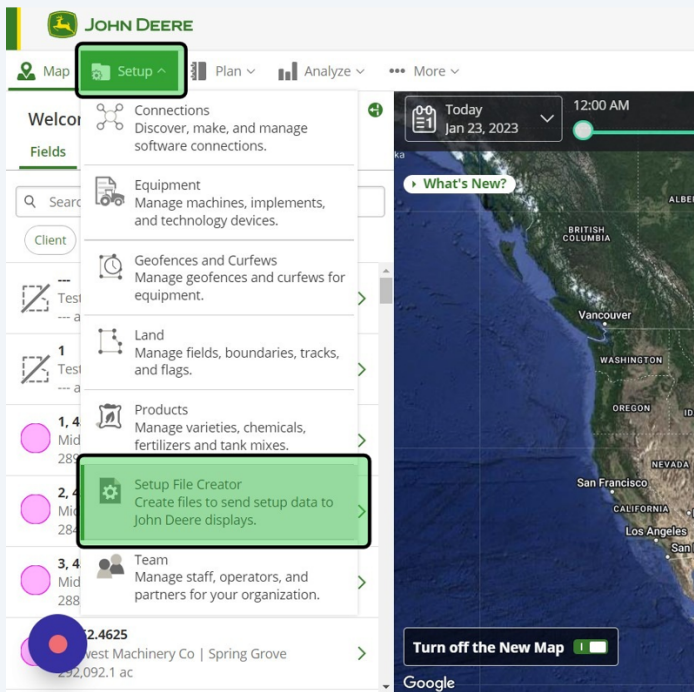

How to create a setup file in Operations Center

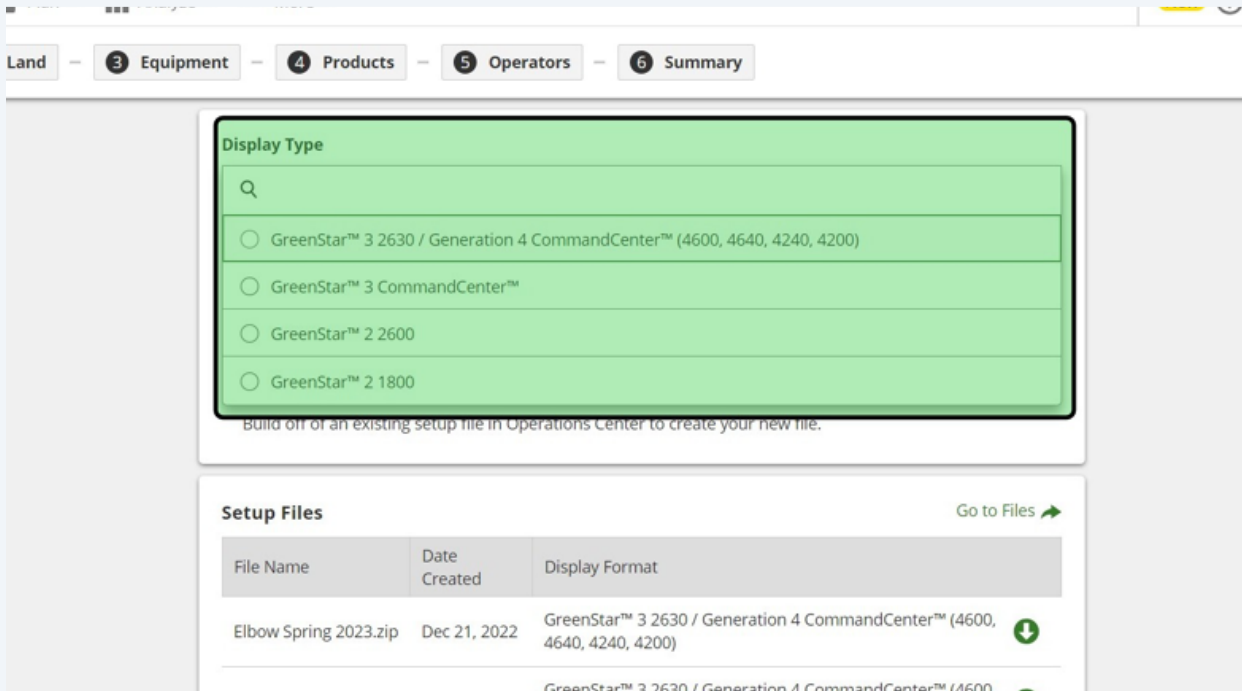
1 Open Operations Center

2 Open "Setup File Creator: Create files to send setup data to John Deere displays" under the "Setup" menu.



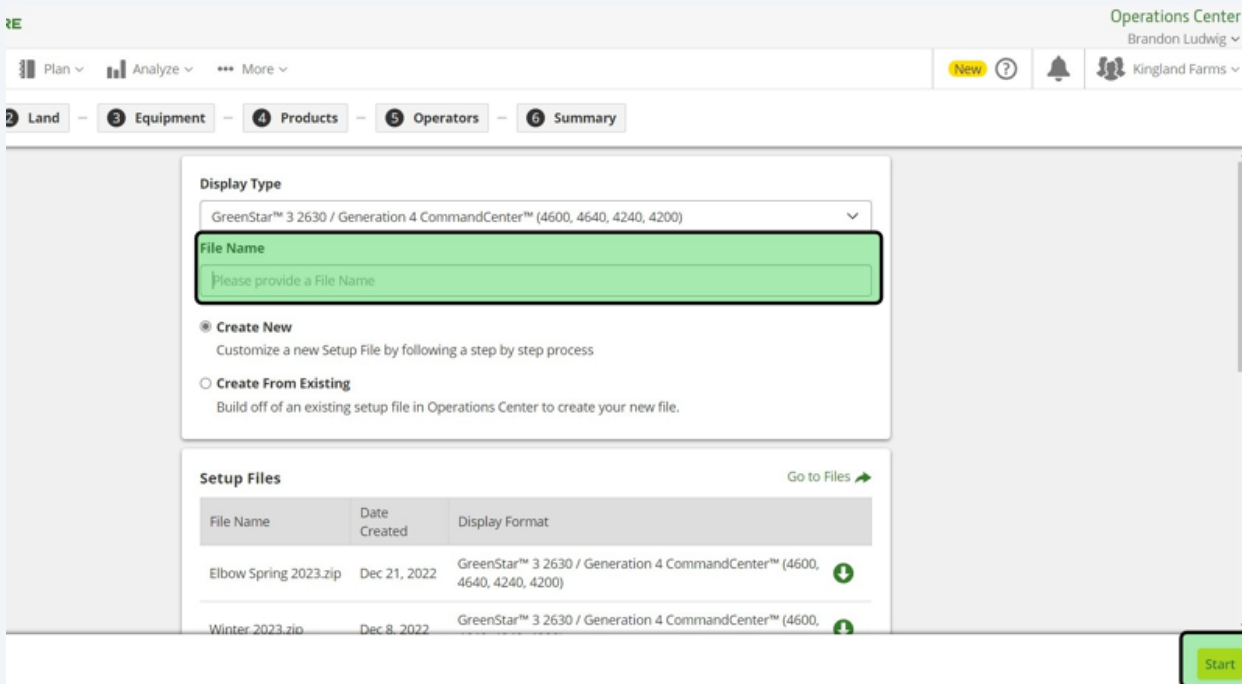

User first selects their display type. This example will show selecting "GreenStar™ 3 2630 / Generation 4 CommandCenter™ (4600, 4640, 4240, 4200)"

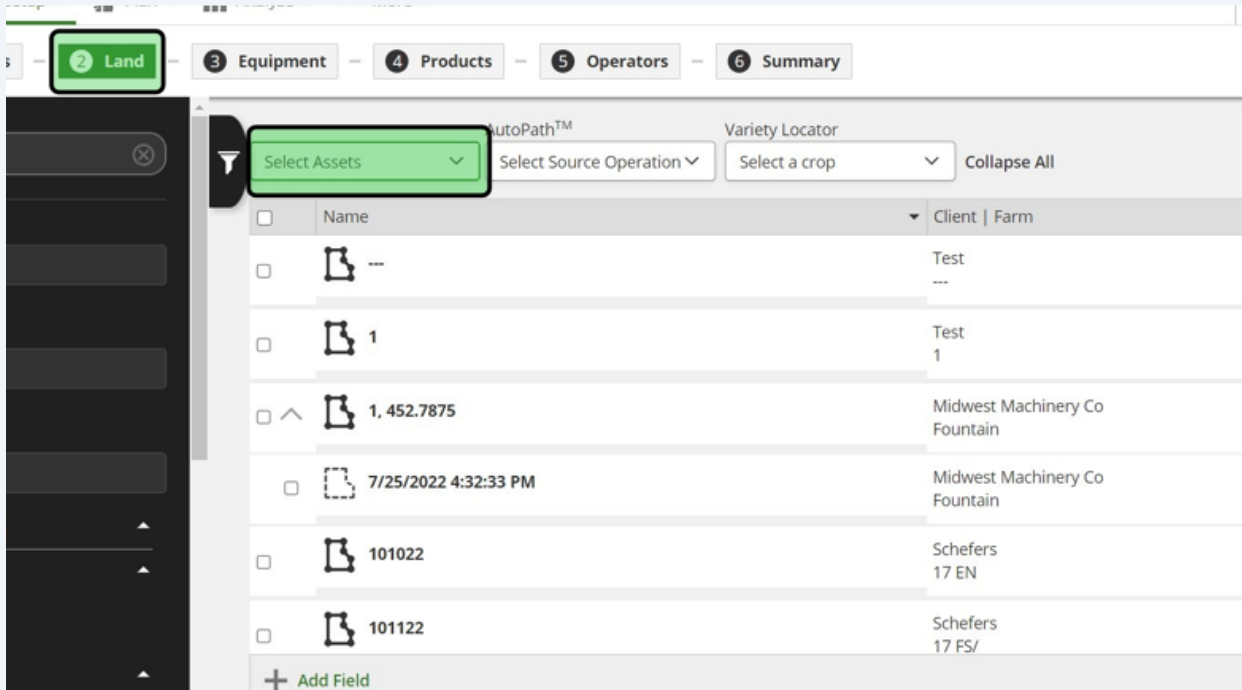
Name the file in the "File Name" field. Then hit "Next" in the bottom right

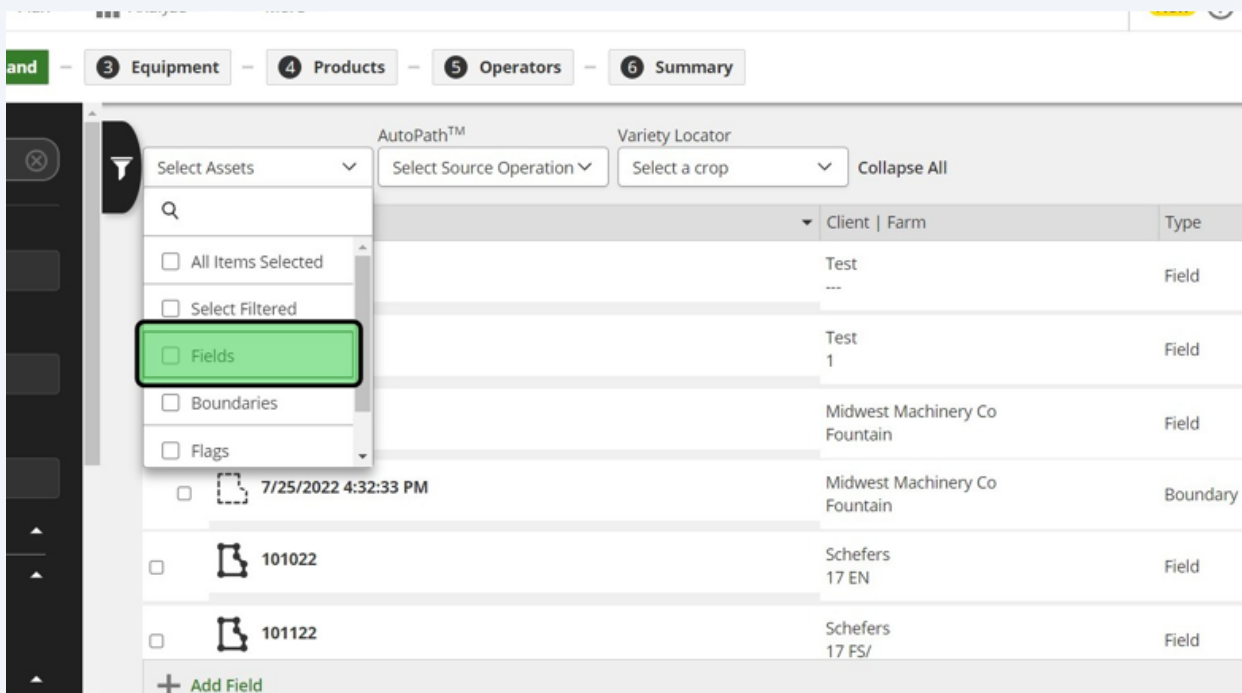

In the "Land" section, user can select the "Bulk select" drop down menu to select all of a certain category. Steps 6,7,8, and 9 show how to bulk select the 4 categories available.



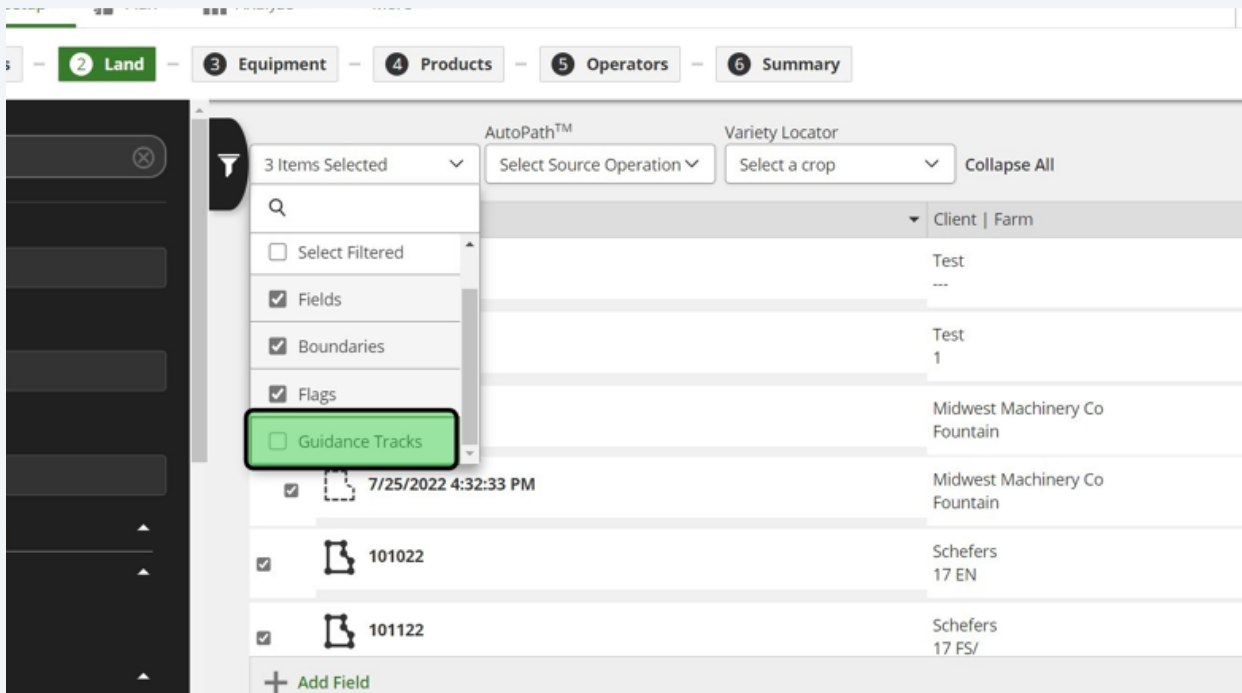

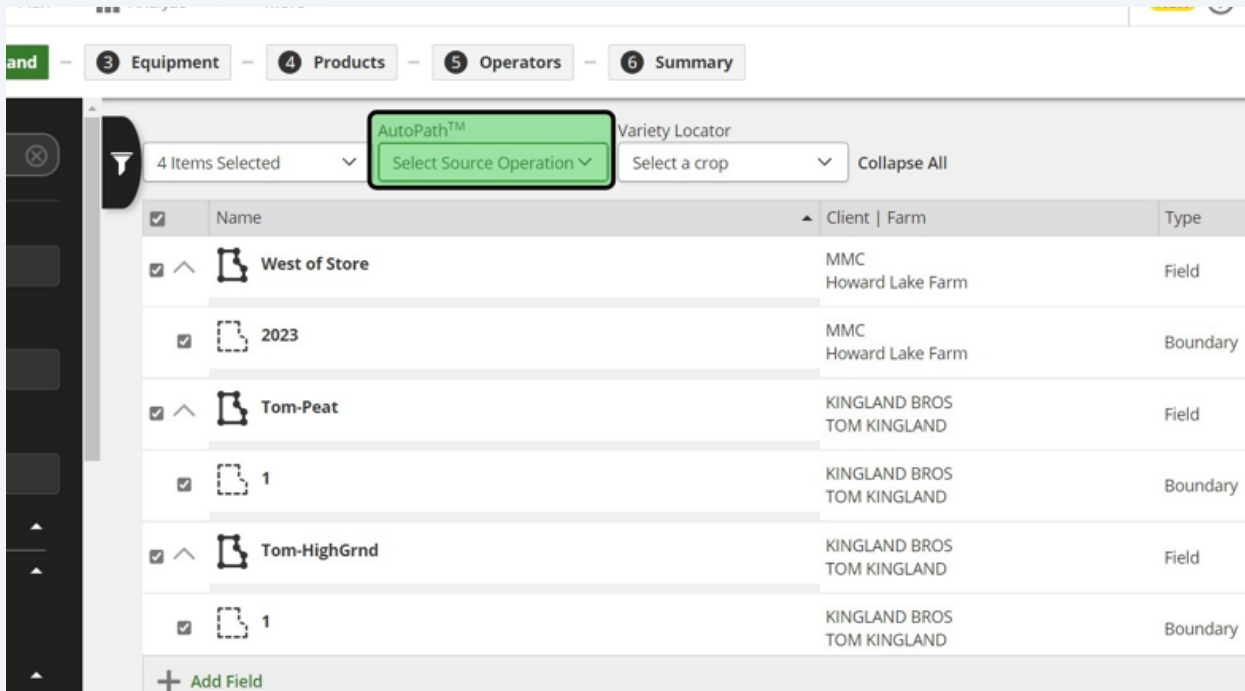

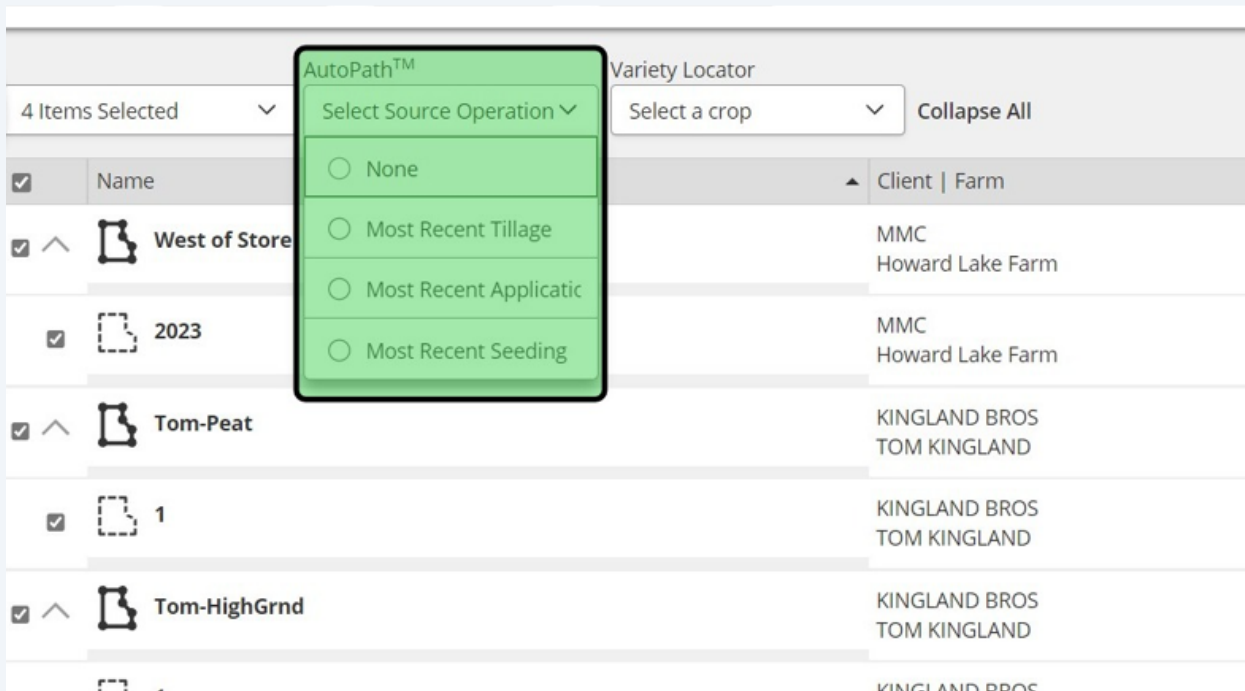


Bulk Selecting AutoPath Lines

10 User can select the AutoPath drop down and bulk select.



11 User can select "Most Recent Seeding, Most Recent Application, or Most Recent Tillage."



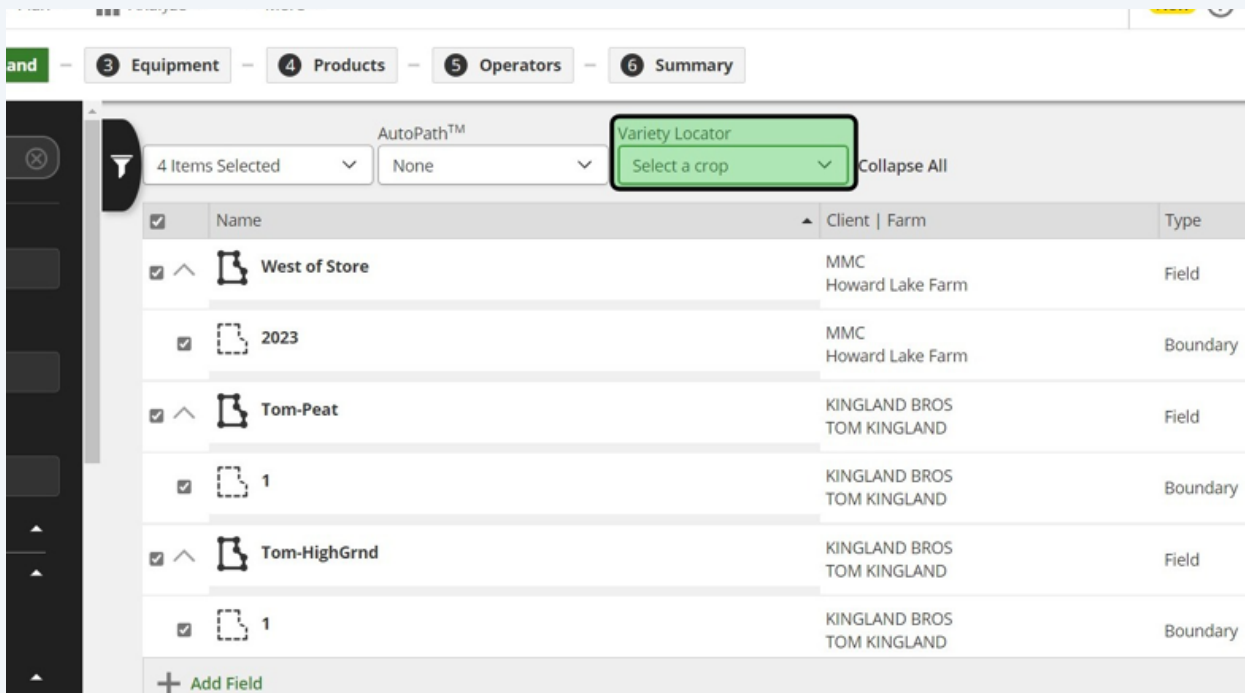


If Customer has done any replant or has multiple applications in a field, make sure to verify correct AutoPath file is selected by navigating to the correct field and looking at the current AutoPath selection.

Variety Locator

User can select the Variety Locator drop down and select which crops they would like to add Variety Locator files for.



Warnings will appear if fields have multiple crops planted in them. User will need to verify which crop they want Variety Locator files for. GS3 2630s can only have one Variety Locator file per field. Gen4 displays can have multiple Variety Locator files per field, but multiple setup files have to be loaded.

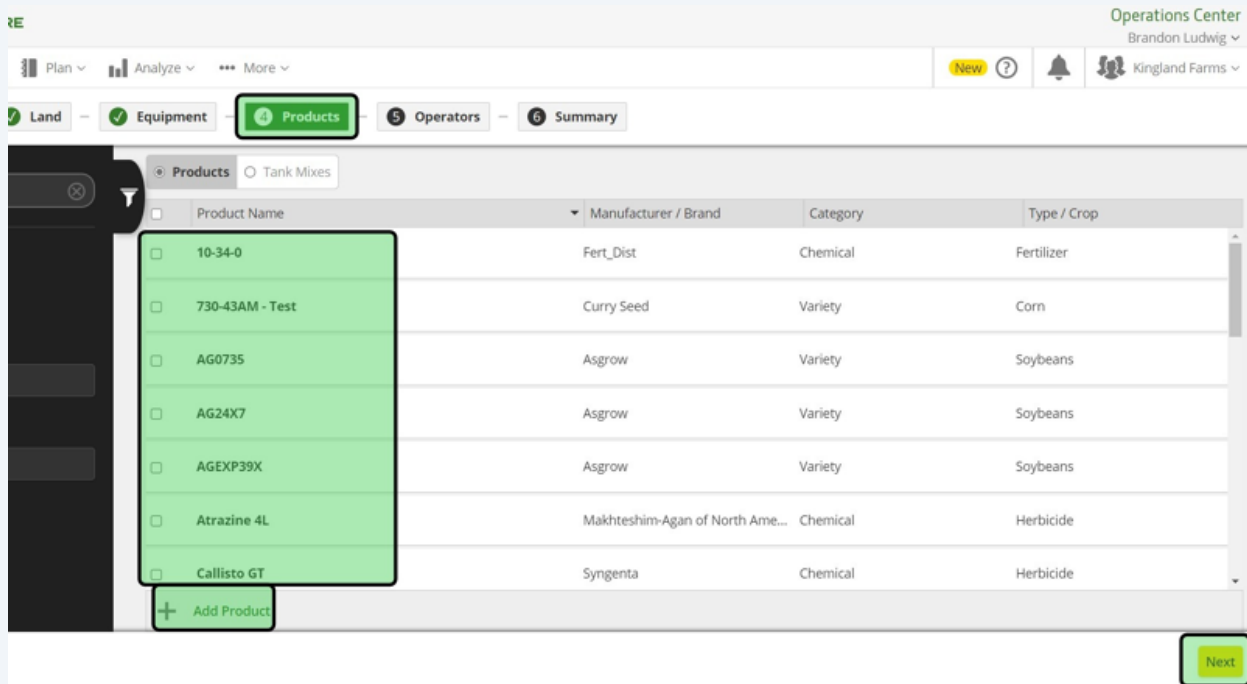

In the "Products" section, user can add all the products they wish to add to the file as well. Products include seeding varieties, chemicals, and fertilizers. If the user needs to add a product, they can add one by hitting the "Add Product" button. Users can also add Tank Mixes they have created.

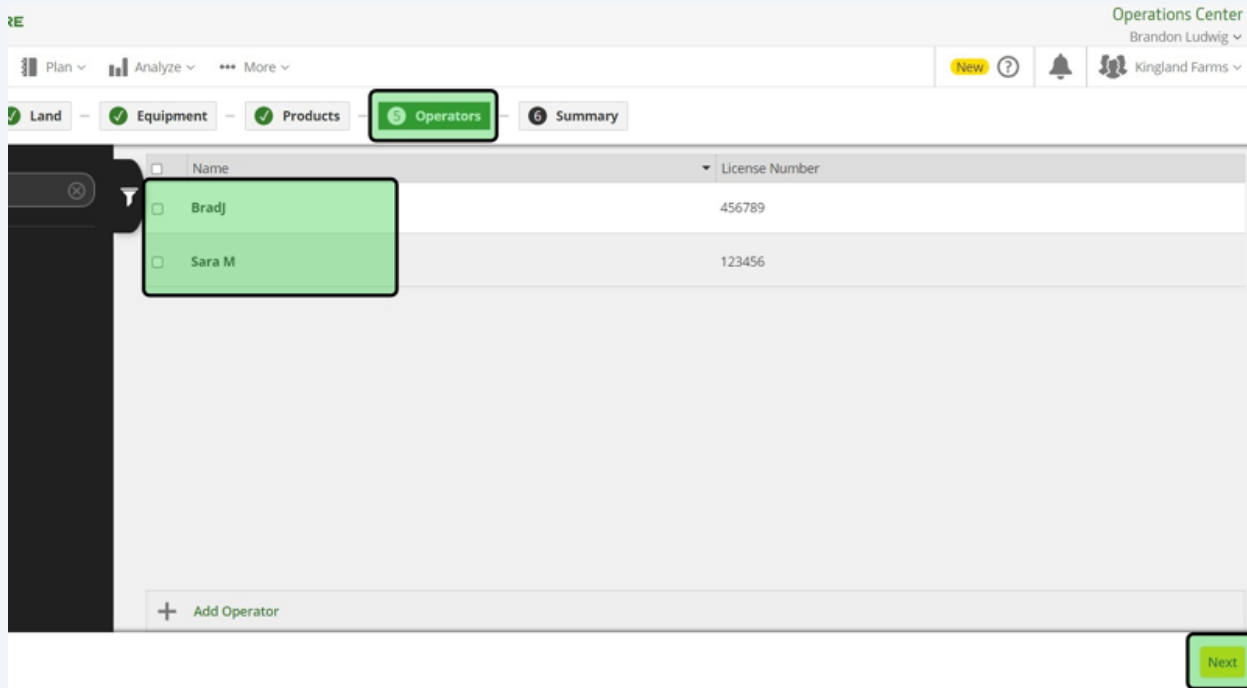


If user is creating a setup file for Harvest, they should add at least one variety of each type of crop they planted for the year.

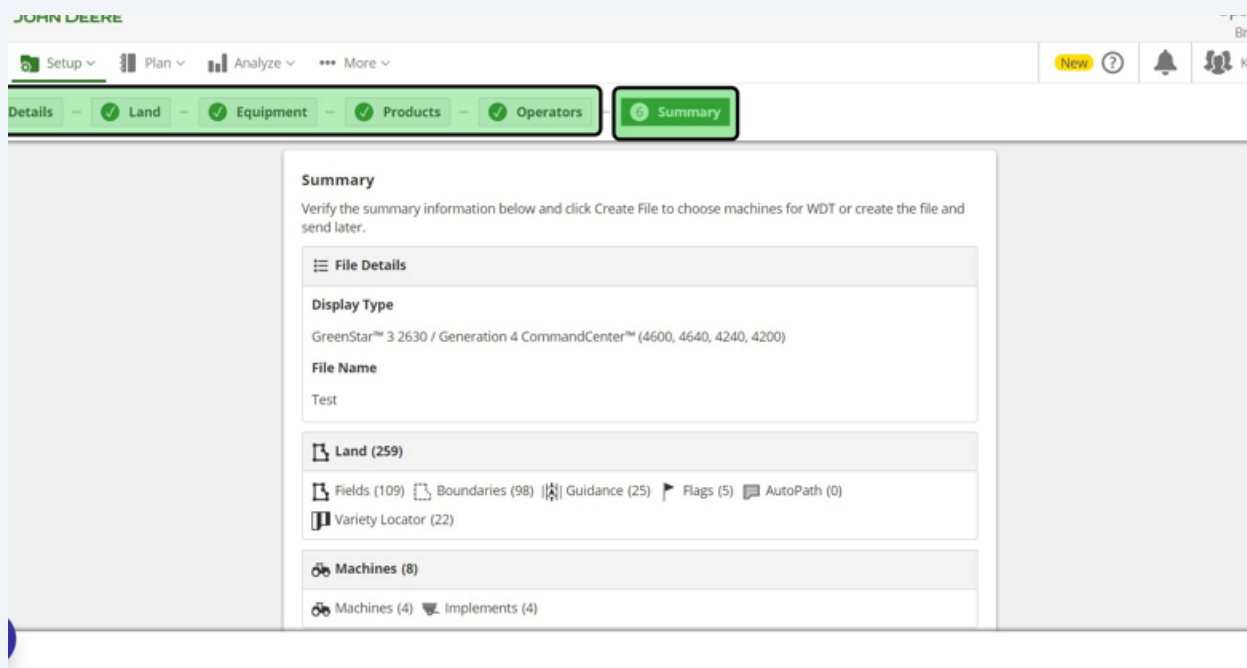
In the Operators section, they can add all the Operators that may operate equipment. Operators are not required to finish creating the setup file.



Summary

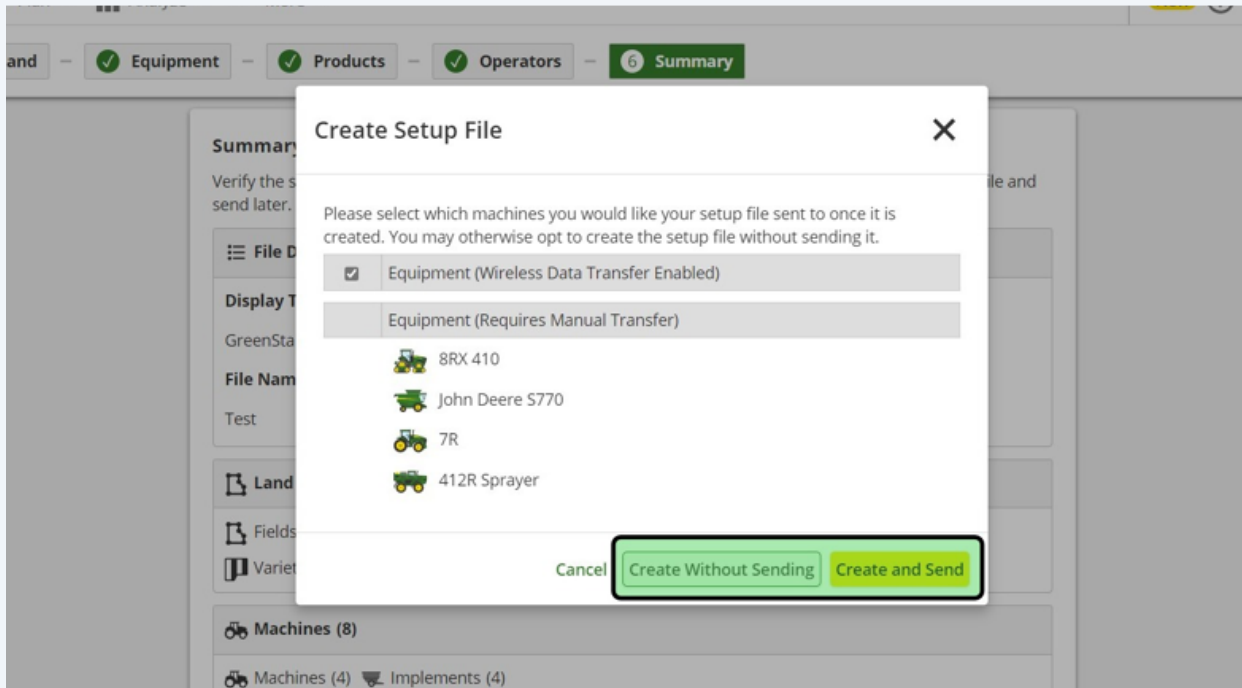

In the "Summary" section, user will need to verify all of the information they have selected up to this point is correct. If not, they can go back to the previous sections and select what they need.

Click "Create Without Sending" or check the boxes next to equipment that can receive data wirelessly and then select "Create and Send" to send the file to the desired equipment.



If sending a setup file to a machine wirelessly, customer should verify there is an ethernet cord connected from the JDLink modem (MTG) to the display.
